- Square Wire 16 gauge 100536 2 feet
- Round Wire 18 gauge 100318 1 ft
- Sterling Silver Sheet 20 Gauge 3X6 100120 (If you prefer to use cooper for the projects instead of Silver you can purchase – Cooper 6X12 20 gauge 132120)
- Saw blades 110306 2/0 (and other sizes if you already have them)
- Saw 110132 (if you already have) The studio has saw frames available for you to use.
- Drill twist #55 349414 (and other sizes if you already have them)
- BurLife stick 117003
- Needle file kit 114797 (or other set if you already have them)

- Sharpie extra fine
- Paper or tracing paper, or contact paper-
- Bring hand tools if you have them- pliers, etc,
- You will need stones to set. You can find your own. Must be cabochons. Could be any shape you like but the more sides the harder to set. I would suggest staying with round or oval. One size being 6 or 8 mm for the ring. A round or oval stone of 10- 25 mm is great for the pendant.
- See Rio -Stones and select Round or oval and search for stones you are excited to set!
