

# Soldering in the Round with Laura Konecne - Supply List

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Students should have a home soldering station set up with an acetylene or butane Blazer torch unless you are using the LAC jewelry studio.

ORDER FROM [www.riogrande.com](http://www.riogrande.com)

- 5 ft of 20 gauge wire (silver is ideal)
- Hard and Medium Silver Solder (ideally in wire form)
- Dandix or Handy Flux
- 1/4 soft kiln brick
- Size #4 and #3/0 jewelers saw blades
- Jewelers saw
- Bench pin
- Some sort of support to hold the form while soldering, perhaps an enameling trivet or pan of pumice. I just use more kiln bricks.
- Needle files
- 20-18gauge sheet metal copper or silver (optional)

ORDER FROM [www.amazon.com](http://www.amazon.com) - pick up from your local hardware store

- Wire cutters, round nose, and chain nose pliers
- 1 sheet of 220 grit sandpaper
- Ultra fine tip sharpie marker
- Dapping block and punches (optional)
