## Workshop with Lon Brauer - Supply List

---

### Colors Needed:

- Thalo Blue
- Purple
- Viridian
- Sap green
- Alizarin crimson
- Cad red
- Cad orange
- Indian yellow
- Burnt umber
- Titanium white
- Ivory black

### Plein Air Kit:

- Palette for paint
- Easel of some sort
- 2 in flat brush and several flats - 1/2in. 1/4in.
- Rigger or two if you have them
- Odorless thinner or gamsol and container for disposal
- Rags or paper towels
- Gessoed panels, stretched canvas or paper - 8x10 is good size but your choice.

### Note on Brushes:

Most of my work is done with four brush sizes - 2in, 1in, 1/2in, 1/4in. (flats) with a heavy reliance on the 2in. I find that the large brush allows me to stay loose and generic as opposed to getting bogged down in minutia. You'll see how it works and perhaps it will be a benefit to you own work.

*Lon will be working in oil paint but you are welcomed to use whatever medium you choose.*
