

## **Community Commitment**

Each Lighthouse ArtCenter community member will be required to make a Community Commitment to help mitigate the spread of the disease.

By making the Community Commitment, you agree to adopt behaviors that advance our collective ability to reduce the transmission of COVID-19. You agree to uphold our shared responsibilities to protect our health and the health of others, and to do your part to help prevent the spread of the virus that causes COVID-19. Specifically, you agree to:

### **Monitor your health**

- Check myself for COVID-19-related symptoms, including checking my temperature before I leave home and before I enter an LAC building
- Whenever I feel ill, stay home and seek medical care
- Be tested for COVID-19 as necessary and directed by CDC
- Isolate and/or quarantine for 2 weeks after coming into contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19
- Report to LAC if you test positive for COVID-19, have come into contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, or have COVID-19 symptoms.
- Follow federal, state, and local requirements regarding quarantining after domestic or international travel

### **Maintain physical distance**

- Keep a distance of at least six feet from others whenever and wherever possible
- Follow guidelines for appointment-only open studios
- Follow protocols for group gatherings both indoors and outdoors both on and off campus
- Not host or participate in any gathering, off campus, that exceeds limits set forth by CDC or Palm Beach County

### **Face coverings**

- Wear an appropriate face covering that fully covers mouth and nose whenever you are on campus unless in a private office or room.
  - Appropriate face coverings defined as N-95 masks, surgical masks, or cotton face masks. Gators, bandanas or t-shirts are not an approved face covering.

### **Practice good hygiene**

- Wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or by using hand sanitizer that contains at least 60 percent alcohol

### **Remain informed**

- Keep up to date on CDC and WHO guidelines for staying healthy
- Read all emails from LAC that pertain to COVID-19 updates
- Agree to comply with all updated health and safety protocols, as conditions change and public health guidance is refined

### **Take care of one another**

- Act with a mindset of mutuality, conscious of how my actions impact other members of the LAC community
- Acknowledge that we are a diverse and inclusive campus where everyone belongs, agreeing not to ostracize any member of our campus community understanding that viruses are no one's fault
- Follow protocols to limit exposure established by Palm Beach and Martin counties, out of respect for the health and safety of the greater community at large.

### **Daily Symptom Check**

As part of our return to in-person classes, all students, faculty, and staff are asked to conduct a personal daily symptom check before coming to campus. Before you leave your home and before you enter an LAC building, check the following:

- In the last two weeks, did you care for or have close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19?
- Are you experiencing a new onset of any of the below symptoms that you cannot attribute to another health condition?
  - Fever or chills (temperature of 100.4°F or greater)
  - Cough
  - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
  - Fatigue
  - Muscle or body aches
  - Headache
  - New loss of taste or smell
  - Sore throat
  - Congestion or runny nose

- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

### **Our Commitment to you**

- Provide disposable face masks for students, faculty or staff that arrive without an approved face covering.
- Provide easy access to hand soap and hand sanitizer in all classrooms, restrooms and front desks.
- Disinfect shared workspaces and frequently touched surfaces before and after each class use, including all shared studio supplies and tools; and disinfecting all shared resources, like phones, switches, pens, handles, and buttons
- To notify students in classes with a confirmed case
