

Drawing with Colored Pencils with Allison Berkner - Supply List

Suggested Materials:

- Paper: Canson Mi-Teintes Pastel Pads (Assorted multi colored pack 9"x12" or 12"x16")
- Strathmore 400 series Toned Grey Sketch Pad 11"x14"
- Strathmore 400 Series Colored Pencil Pad 12"x9" or 11"x14"
- Optional/Other suggestions: Strathmore 400 Series Heavyweight Drawing Pad 8"x10" or bigger—If you want extra paper or to have more variety than listed A sketchbook/notepad no smaller than 5"x7" (I recommend something spiral bound, and a sketchbook made for dry materials, not wet or mixed media. This will be used for light sketching, practicing, exercises, note taking etc. Recommended brands are Canson or Strathmore. If you want to be exact, look for 80-140lbs pressed paper)
- Pencils: Prisma Color Premiere 24 colored pencil set. It should have a butterfly on the cover of the packaging.
- Graphite Pencils (At most, a 6 piece set is recommended 2H-6B, but not required, we will be using graphite pencils for light sketching)
- Other Tools: A pencil sharpener (a metal pencil sharpener is highly recommended)
- 1 regular eraser
- 1 kneaded eraser
- 12-inch ruler (metal cork back is highly recommended)
